It is organised annually by the National Volunteer & Philanthropy Centre (NVPC), who is the steward of the City of Good vision, with support from the Ministry of Culture, Community and Youth (MCCY).

A City of Good is made up of people who care for one another, and take action to make society a better for all. *President's Volunteerism & Philanthropy Awards 2020 Special Edition - Our Finest Hour in the City of Good* seeks to recognise individuals, organisations and leaders who are **exceptional relational and multiplier givers*** during the COVID-19 pandemic and have voluntarily devoted their time, talent, treasure and/or voice to create a positive impact in the community during the COVID-19 pandemic period in the first half of 2020 . Giving can be in the form of time (volunteerism), in-kind/cash/medical donations (philanthropy), and/or being advocates for causes or needs in society (sharing of voice).

Through the *President's Volunteerism & Philanthropy Awards 2020 Special Edition* awards, we hope to honour the efforts by these astounding individuals, organisations and leaders for their contribution during these unprecedented times, and to inspire the wider public to be more other-centred in giving their best for others to build a City of Good.
